Drop-In/Stroke of the Week Updates

- As of May 1, start time for drop-in play to be moved up to 8am, except that Men's Friday drop in will continue at 9 am for a few more weeks (mostly because Alan didn't want to get up so early). The time will move up to 7am sometime in June.
- Women's drop-in will move from Monday to Wednesday and the Stroke of the Week will move to Monday.
